**Purpose:** Provide backup to the professors and staff of Reformation International Theological Seminary (RITS) in the area of grading, reading papers, and eventually mentoring students from around the world in various subjects at various educational levels both non-degree and degree level.

**Qualifications:** Specific skills in particular offered subjects of RITS with abilities matched to subjects

- Committed to confessional Reformed theology
- Able and willing to work within RITS parameters to provide this service to students (predominantly subsidized)
- Seminary or comparable training ideal
- Other qualifications may suffice for specific subjects.
- Willing to make commitments (limited as they may be) and keep them so as to provide a rapid turn around for student papers.
- English language proficiency
- Other languages, especially French and Chinese helpful, but not required.

**Type of Person sought:**

1. Pastor desiring unusual ministry opportunities that will not take him away from his flock.
2. Trained seminarian or missionary without a call or with a few extra hours a month to donate.
3. Seminary students wanting some practicum in the area of discipleship.
4. Disabled or retired minister/professor or otherwise qualified person.
5. Any capable church member who has particular training or expertise in any of the subject areas, including but not limited to: church history; counseling; Greek; Hebrew; Latin; English language and composition skills; writing composition and papers; written English as Second Language instruction.

All work will be overseen by RITS. The Team will be graduated and delegated various responsibilities, so those interested in working with other graders can work themselves into team leaders as the students grow. This is intended to be a serious division of labor to keep RITS expenses down and minister to as large a number of students as possible. We are looking initially for between twenty and thirty team members in the next two years. The work will begin slow, but will give us time to familiarize you with the courses.
